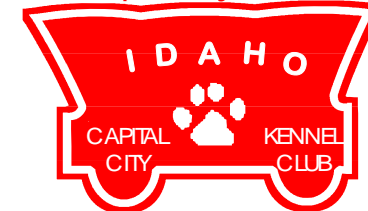

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors under cover on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 100' X 100'.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the owner by email listed on the official entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Ann Kruger at clintmom@earthlink.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules attached (reverse side of the official AKC entry) are not acceptable.

Illegible, unsigned, or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue
Second Place.....Red
Third Place.....Yellow
Fourth Place.....White
Qualifying Score.....Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A 3-Streamer rosette and jump bar will be awarded any dog/handler teams completing a MACH or PAX.

Please notify the Trial Secretary if you may be close to either of these titles at our trial.

A dog toy valued at three to five dollars will be awarded to all dogs that place First in their respective height and class.

NOTE: New rules go into effect September 1, 2010.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The ICCKC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The ICCKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the ICCKC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund one-half of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such a claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked no later than the day before the agility trial.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space-There is plenty of crating space in the arena or the surrounding stalls. Also, crating is available around the outside of the arena. Crates may be left overnight; however, the ICCKC and the Expo Idaho will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food-there will be a food vendor inside the large expo building where the Conformation takes place. There are also many fast food eateries on Glenwood, which runs beside the grounds. We will be providing lunch for the volunteers that work 2 or more classes for the day.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

DIRECTIONS TO EXPO IDAHO

Eastbound on Interstate 84:

Take Eagle Exit 46; Travel North on Eagle Rd 5 Miles. Turn right on Chinden Blvd & go 4 miles. Turn left on Glenwood St. EXPO IDAHO will be on your right. Continue ahead to the baseball stadium and turn right at the "Livestock Entrance" (also called Demeyer St). Go to the first gate and turn right and drive to the check-in tent and turn left, then go straight to the agility ring.

Westbound on Interstate 84:

Take Cole/Overland Exit 50A. At the light, turn left and travel North on to the end of Cole Rd. approx. 4 miles. Turn left on Mountain View Dr, go to the next light, turn right on Glenwood. Go down the hill and straight through the light. EXPO IDAHO will be on your right. Continue ahead to the baseball stadium and turn right at the "Livestock Entrance" (also called Demeyer St). Go to the first gate and turn right and drive to the check-in tent and turn left, then go straight to the agility ring.

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 20% online entries (Fri, Sat & Sun 66 runs) and 80% paper entries (Fri, Sat & Sun 264 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Move-ups: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6 p.m. MDT, Monday October 11, 2010. Saturday and Sunday move-ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing, by the Trial Secretary, no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes on Friday and Saturday. Note: once a trial has closed its entries, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B.
