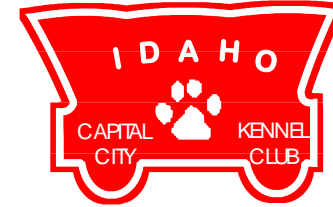

Judging:

Judging will start at 7:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. Agility Excellent check-in, briefing, and course walk-through will take place prior to that time, to be specified in entry confirmation.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class. Dark green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles earned. A plush dog toy valued at \$1.00 to \$3.00 will be awarded to 1st place finishers in all classes. **A 3-streamer rosette and jump bar will be awarded any dog/handler teams completing a MACH or PAX.** All awards must be claimed at the show.

Please let the Trial Secretary know ahead of time if you are close to a MACH or PAX Title.

DIRECTIONS TO EXPO IDAHO (formerly Western Idaho Fairgrounds):

Eastbound on Interstate 84:

Take Eagle Exit 46; Travel North on Eagle Rd 5 Miles. Turn right on Chinden Blvd & go 4 miles. Turn left on Glenwood St. EXPO IDAHO will be on your right. Continue ahead to the baseball stadium and turn right at the "Livestock Entrance" (also called Backstretch St). Go to the second gate and turn right and drive straight to the agility ring on your right.

Westbound on Interstate 84:

Take Cole/Overland Exit 50A. At the light, turn left and travel North on to the end of Cole Rd. approx. 4 miles. Turn left on Mountain View Dr, go to the next light, turn right on Glenwood. Go down the hill and straight through the light. EXPO IDAHO will be on your right. Continue ahead to the baseball stadium and turn right at the "Livestock Entrance" (also called Backstretch St). Go to the second gate and turn right and drive straight to the agility ring on your right.

Important Information for Exhibitors

This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

- ❖ **No conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, or telephone entries will be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules attached (reverse side of the official AKC entry form) are not acceptable.**
- ❖ Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing.
- ❖ **Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the signature requirement waived** otherwise they may not be delivered on time. The secretary will not pick up entries being held for signature and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered.
- ❖ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials, ICCKC will refund one-half of entry fees for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such a claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked no later than the day before the agility trial. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, it is impossible to open, or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- ❖ Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the owner address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.
- ❖ **Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ❖ **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Please clean up after your dog..**
- ❖ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- ❖ Novice dogs and their handlers will **NOT** be given a contact familiarization prior to start of judging.
- ❖ Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER AGILITY: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older, that are registered with the AKC or that have obtained an AKC ILP OR PAL or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

AGILITY CLASS INFORMATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Classes Offered (Standard and Jumpers With Weaves, Regular and Preferred)

Novice Class is divided into Divisions A and B. **Division A** is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner or a member of the Owner's household. **Division B** is for dogs and handlers that do not meet the requirements for Division A.

Open Class is open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

Excellent Class A is open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title and have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

Excellent Class B Open to dogs that have acquired the Excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

The Preferred Classes will be offered at these trials and are open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC agility regulations. The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Agility Class and Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Agility Class and the Regular Jumpers With Weaves Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time **must** enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Standard Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard and JWW).

Note: It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the dog is entered in the correct class(es). Always double-check your entry before submitting. If in doubt check the AKC agility regulations, <http://www.akc.org/registration/rules/reagil.cfm>

Move-ups: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6 p.m. MDT, Monday July 19, 2010. Sunday move-ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing, by the Trial Secretary, no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes on Saturday. Note: once a trial has closed its entries, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B.

Please be sure that you enter your mixed breed dogs as –All American— on your entry form. This is the only breed description that will be used on the entry forms.

YOU CAN NOW ENTER VIA AKC's ONLINE ENTRY SERVICES

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 20% online entries (Sat & Sun 66 runs) and 80% paper entries (Sat & Sun 264 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48- hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Trial Site

Crating—There is plenty of room for crating in the arena or the surrounding stalls. Also crating is available around the outside of the arena. It will be hot so please bring plenty of water for you and your dogs.

Food—there will not be a food vendor at our trial this time. There are many fast food eateries on Glenwood, which runs beside the grounds.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
