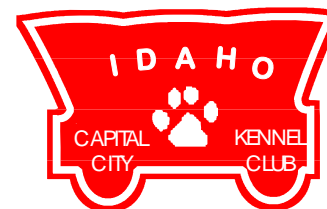

**Judging:**

Judging will start at 8:30 a.m. Friday and Saturday and 8:00 a.m. on Sunday. Excellent check-in, briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to that time, to be specified in entry confirmation.

**Awards:**

Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division, in each class. Dark green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. A dog toy, valued at least \$3, will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers in all classes. A qualifying score is required for all awards. Rosettes will be awarded for Titles earned. **A 3-streamer Rosette and jump bar will be awarded any dog/handler teams completing a MACH or PAX.** All awards must be claimed at the show. If you are near a MACH or PAX Title, please notify the trial secretary in advance of the trial.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER AGILITY:** This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the AKC or are registered breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP, or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

### Important Information for Exhibitors

- ❖ No conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible or telephone entries will be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules attached (reverse side) of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- ❖ Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing.
- ❖ Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the signature requirement waived otherwise they may not be delivered on time. The secretary will not pick up entries being held for signature and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered.
- ❖ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials, ICCKC will refund one-half of entry fees for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such a claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked no later than the day before the agility trial. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, it is impossible to open, or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- ❖ Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the owner email address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.
- ❖ Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ❖ All dogs must be on a leash **at all times** except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Please clean up after your dog.
- ❖ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- ❖ Novice dogs and their handlers will **NOT** be given a contact familiarization prior to start of judging.
- ❖ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

### **DIRECTIONS TO CANYON COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS:**

From I-84, take Exit 29. Head South at the light .on 21<sup>st</sup> Ave. You will see signs for Fairgrounds, Airport, Farm City and College of Idaho. Go about 1 mile. Immediately after the railroad tracks, turn left on Stocktrail Rd. Proceed about 100 feet you will see the building on the right. It's a big yellow building with a sign that says "Canyon County Fair Building".

### NEW SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

**When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

**Note:** It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the dog is entered in the correct class(es). Always double-check your entry before submitting. If in doubt check the AKC agility regulations, <http://www.akc.org/registration/rules/reagil.cfm>

**Move-ups:** Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6 pm MDT, Monday March 15, 2010. Saturday and Sunday move-ups will be allowed provided the request is received in writing, by the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog finishes on Friday and Saturday. Note: Once a trial has closed its entries, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B.

**HEIGHT CARDS:** All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. Dogs that do not have a valid Jump Height Card must be measured by a judge of record for that trial and will only be effective for that set of trials, excluding dogs jumping 24 inch or 26 inch height division. If VMO or REP is present, then all dogs without a valid height card must be measured regardless of the jump height entered.

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. ## INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.
