

# Spring Classes Sponsored By The Idaho Capital City Kennel Club

All seven classes will be held on Wednesday evenings from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m., beginning on April 14<sup>th</sup> for seven weeks in Ann Morrison Park (off Americana Blvd. then left toward the river around corner by children's playgrounds). Class fee for all the classes will be \$60.00/person or \$30.00/person for ICCKC members for all seven weeks of classes.

## Beginning Show Handling – Carol Green & Mitch Foust, Instructors (minimum dog age: 4 months)

Beginning class is for those who have not yet shown their dogs and who want to understand presentation of their particular breed. Limited experience should not prevent enrolling in the beginning class.

## Advanced Show Handling - Pat Gonzales & Renee Drake, Instructors (minimum dog age: 4 months)

The first night will be signing up and talking about which type of show lead you might use and other general questions about showing.

## Introduction to Agility – Jan Skurzynski & Dale Mahoney instructors (minimum dog age: 1 year)

Instruction will focus on introducing agility obstacles to handler and dog. Using training methods that are motivational and positive and to a good agility foundation as well as building a good working relationship with your dog.

## Rally – Amy Rosebrock instructor (minimum dog age: 6 months)

Dogs must know basic obedience to include heel, sit, down and come before you take this class.

## Canine Good Citizen (CGC) – Lincea Ruth Instructor (minimum dog age: 1 year)

Teach your dog to have manners at home and in the community. Rabies certification is no longer needed, but you will be required to sign the Responsible Dog Owners Pledge attesting to having your dog under regular veterinary care. The first five weeks will be practice and the last two weeks will be the actual CGC test to receive your AKC CGC Certificate. ***Prerequisite:*** All dogs must already be able to perform basic obedience before the start of this class (*sit, down, heel, stay and come*).
