## CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST

Testing from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m.

CGC is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs that have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen® Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. This test is for all dogs whether purebred or mixed breed. Rabies certification is no longer needed, but you will be required to sign the Responsible Dog Owners Pledge attesting to having your dog under regular veterinary care. All dogs passing the CGC test receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club. To be certified the dog must complete exercises that include the following: accept a friendly stranger, sit politely for petting, allow grooming, walk on a loose leash, walk through a crowd, sit and down on command, stay in place, come when called, accept other dogs. CGC registration will be first come, first served on the day of match. **No pre - registrations will be taken**. Cost is \$10.00 day of only.

#### **AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises

and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may

be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for

any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but

whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to

the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED."

Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## **Match Conformation**

Miscellaneous classes will be provided, but will not go to group judging. If you are entering a breed currently recognized in the AKC miscellaneous class, you must provide a breed standard approved by the U. S. National breed club with your entry form.

All classes divided by sex and age.

Puppy Classes: 4-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months

Open: 12 month and older

Parade of Champions: Exhibition only for breed Champions or dogs holding AKC accepted titles. Parade of Champions will take place before the group judging. Please send in a brief biography for your dog with your entry.

**Mixed Breed dogs** entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "**MIXED BREED**." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrant.

## **Obedience**

Sanctioned AKC Obedience match - one ring - All AKC obedience rules will apply for this event.

### **Plan C Obedience match – three rings**

**Rules:** This match is an excellent opportunity to work/play your dog through the exercises AND to tell the judge what you want to do in the ring!

-Dogs are not limited by title to which class they may enter.

-No scoring or evaluation unless requested.

-Training aids such as treats or toys may be taken into the ring.

-Corrections are allowed but shall be limited to verbal corrections or gentle guiding of the dog.

-Exhibitor may enter a class more than once, but any 2nd run-through shall be delayed until all first run-throughs are completed.

-Sits and downs will be performed in a ring separate from the individual exercises.

-No ribbons, placements or trophies shall be awarded.

-Additional run-throughs of same class \$3.00 each day of match.

## Match Showmanship

Adult: Women and men combined, 18 years old and up.

Juniors: Dog must be owned by the handler or a member of his/her family.

Novice Junior: 9-11 yrs old & have not won 3 first places

Novice Intermediate : 12-14 yrs old & have not won 3 first places

Novice Senior : 15-18 years old & have not won 3 first places.

Open Junior : 9-11 years old & have won 3 first places.

Open Intermediate : 12-14 years old & have won 3 first places.

Open Senior : 15-18 years old & have won 3 first places.

### Eligibility /Additional rules:

No dog which is a champion of record may be entered except in obedience, Agility, CGC, Parade of champions, Adult/Junior Showmanship or Veterans. Professional handlers may only handle dogs they own or co-own. Classes are open only to AKC breeds with the exception of the CGC which is open to all dogs. Committee members may exhibit their dogs.

**\*\*Each dog must have a separate entry form which includes the AKC agreement. Copy the enclosed AKC form as needed. \*\***

The Idaho Capital City Kennel Club, Inc. will not be responsible for loss or injury to any dogs, persons, or property. There will be absolutely no intensive or abusive training on the premises. Judging assignments subject to change without prior notice. This will be an outdoor match, held rain or shine.

Parking: Parking will be allowed along *one* side of the entrance road, beyond the established ICCKC barricade only. Any oversized vehicles must park in the lots. We must maintain a two way flow of traffic in and out during our event.

### Awards

Ribbons will be awarded in each conformation, agility and showmanship class, 1st –4th place and for Best of Breed.

Rosettes will be awarded for Best Adult in Match, Best Puppy in Match, 1st-4th in each Group, Best Junior Showman, Best Adult Handler and Parade of Champions. Trophies will be awarded for Best Adult in Match, Best Puppy in Match and First in Groups. Agility class winners will receive a dog toy. No awards provided for Plan C obedience classes. Scoring only upon request.

Note that all dogs competing in agility must be able to present a valid official AKC Jump Height Card at the match or be measured at the match.

### MATCH AGILITY INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Classes Offered (Standard and Jumpers With Weaves, Regular and Preferred)  
Novice Class is divided into Divisions A and B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner or a member of the Owner's household. Division B is for dogs and handlers that do not meet the requirements for Division A.

Open Class is open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

Excellent Class A is open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title and have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

Excellent Class B Open to dogs that have acquired the excellent title (in that class Std. / JWW).

The Preferred Classes will be offered at this match. The preferred classes are new to AKC as of September 2002 and are open to any dog eligible to enter an agility match as defined in Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC agility regulations. The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Agility Class and Preferred Jumpers With Weaves Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Agility Class and the Regular Jumpers With Weaves Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same match. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Standard Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard and JWW). Note: It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the dog is entered in the correct class(es). Always double-check your entry before submitting.
